Loudon Avenue Christian Church Scholarship Eligibility Guidelines



The following guidelines provide a framework that the Scholarship Committee of Loudon Avenue Christian Church will use to determine eligibility for the annual scholarship awards. These guidelines provide an objective way to determine that all applicants meet requirements necessary to be considered.

High School Graduating Seniors and First Time Applicants

Applicants must:

- Be <u>actively engaged</u> in life of Loudon Avenue Christian Church.
- Have a minimum grade point average of 2.0.
- Complete the application and submit it no later than <u>11:59 PM</u>, on the <u>first Sunday in May</u>.
 - Write an Essay answering the guiding question: Why is a college education important to you? (Minimum of 200 words)
 - Submit two (2) Reference Letters References should include contact information and may not be related to applicant.
 - o Document volunteer service and/or extracurricular activities.
 - Submit High School transcript(s) or a transcript last two semesters of college grades
- Submit college acceptance letter from an accredited school.
- Provide proof of registration as full-time student (minimum 12 hours).

LACC Scholarship Eligibility Guidelines - College Student Renewal

Applicants must:

- Be <u>actively engaged</u> in life of Loudon Avenue Christian Church.
- Have a minimum grade point average of 2.3.
- Complete the application and submit it no later than 11:59 PM, on the first Sunday in May.
- Submit a transcript: Last two semesters of grades.
- Provide proof of registration as a full-time student (minimum 12 hours). Students must carry 12 hours or have a letter from the school stipulating that fewer hours are considered full time.

Please Note: This scholarship is open to any student who is seeking postsecondary education. Postsecondary education is any education after graduation from high school. It includes accredited two- and four-year colleges, as well as accredited postsecondary career training programs. The term "college" is used as shorthand to indicate any type of accredited postsecondary education or training program.
